The Mohawk Valley Stewardship Council's (MVSC) primary focus is the restoration, development and protection of historic White Sulphur Springs Ranch (WSSR) for the benefit of our community, our schools, children, veterans and the disabled. The WSSR has been a hub of community activities since the mid-1800s. It has been a venue for weddings, family picnics, recreational swimming activities, reunions, and many other community events.

White Sulphur Springs Ranch was created in 1852. The ranch house was established as a hotel in the early 1860s and served as a stagecoach stop until 1907. Since then it has been a private home, a B&B, and a community recreation venue largely because of its warm spring fed swimming pool. Having ceased operation in 2000, structures fell into disrepair. The MVSC was able to obtain a grant for acquisition, and along with a substantial donation from the landowner, closed escrow on the WSSR property, October 20, 2010.

The restored property will again serve as a community gathering place and a venue for environmental education including a small museum, amphitheaters, hiking and biking trails, ethnobotanical gardens, and swimming pool. The Ranch enjoys a scenic overlook of the beautiful Mohawk Valley which sits at the base of the northern Sierra Nevada mountain range in Plumas County between Eureka Peak and Haskell Peak.
