In collaboration with the DeLand & Greater West Volusia Chamber of Commerce and Stetson University, Leadership West Volusia draws together business and community leaders from diverse backgrounds and experiences to learn about challenging community issues while enhancing their leadership skills. Beginning with a Team-Building Workshop, attendees learn to challenge assumptions through both their personal lens, as well as the perspectives of fellow team members. PROGRAM GOALS
