Boulder City Art Guild Helps To Make the Season Bright

Boulder City's Art Guild is actively and artfully helping to make this holiday season bright and beautiful throughout the community. The season began with BCAG's annual **Winter ArtFest** held on November 7th & 8th at the Recreation Center on Arizona Street. Many friends of the arts, tourists and residents, paid a visit to the art show. Art work in all mediums and fine crafts was available for purchase and artists enjoyed visiting with guests. The community gathered together to enjoy art and kick off this holiday season at the Winter ArtFest. **"Celebrating the Seasons" art exhibit** reception was held on November 21st at the Guild's art gallery & gift shop in the Boulder Dam Hotel. Artists and guests enjoyed a festive evening of artful fun and food. The Guild was open to visitors during evening hours, which allowed many to begin their holiday

shopping. The exhibit continues through December 31st. The Guild Gallery has the distinction of being the first co-op art gallery in southern Nevada.

BCAG members are participating in the Boulder City Community Club's annual "**Doodlebug Craft Bazaar**" by working on committees before and during the event, which will be held on Saturday, December 5th, 9–4, at the Rec Center. This year the BCCC's Doodlebug character logo was given a makeover by BCAG artist, Dotty Fenner.

The Chamber of Commerce will be hosting "Santa Picture Day" in coordination with the Doodlebug Bazaar, inviting children young and old to have a photo taken with Santa. Prior to this event, BCAG

artists have been working long hours to create **Santa's winter wonderland** – a 40' x 20' canvas backdrop - artfully designed and painted by BCAG artist, Tommy Tucker. Assisting Tommy in the execution of this huge project is BCAG artist, Jan Schaeffer along with guild artists Charme Curtin, Rudi Kraft, Georgia Lawson and Lee Moses. The work of these artists is essential in insuring Santa has the right seasonal background for years to come.

Saturday, December 12^{th} will be a day packed with artful festivities. The Guild Gallery opens at 10 a.m. and will participate in the **AAUW Home Tour** from 1-4 pm. The Gallery will remain open into the evening as one of the

stops on the **Chamber's Wine Walk**. Artists will be in attendance for both the Home Tour during the day and the Wine Walk in the evening, 4 – 8 pm. The gallery and gift shop is a perfect place to purchase unique gift items this holiday season. December 12th is also the last chance to enter in the Guild's fund raising raffle for a grand prize, a pair of tickets to Vegas PBS Downton Abbey Tea at the Wynn, held on December 19th. 
Interview with a BCAG artist – TOMMY (Domino) TUCKER

Tommy has loved art since as far back as he can remember. He has loved learning for as far back as he can remember. Tommy combines his love of art and learning and produces all manner of creative works. He has an extensive background in sign design and creation. He also worked at set painting for major movie studios for many years in Hollywood. His vintage signs are well known as are the studios he worked for, including Disney, Paramount, Universal, Warner







works in a variety of mediums and each piece of art he creates has a story he is willing to share. Tommy has had a life full of joy and tragedy, beginning as a sickly child. He has cleared the challenging hurdles with much effort and in the process, has continued to develop his art. Tommy dedicates a good portion of his time and art to "missions" that are close to his heart, most especially the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. He shared that, working with those who volunteer offers him an insight into a variety of personalities and backgrounds, creating a vast network to work with. As a member of the BCAG, Tommy serves on the board as the director of Outside Exhibits. He currently has established a team of artists to paint a

canvas backdrop for the Boulder City Chamber of Commerce's "Santa Picture Day." The backdrop is 40' x 20' and will depict a winter wonderland of Tommy's creation.
