# "Don't be fooled by deceptive campaign ads!"

#### BALLOT QUESTIONS (GREEN = YES VOTE RED = NO VOTE)

- **1- VOTE NO** Removes public election of the University of Nevada Board of Regents. Authorizes the state legislature to control it. This was attempted in 2020 and was defeated by voters!
- **2 VOTE YES** Updates the state constitution related to mentally ill and physically impaired or disabled persons.
- **3 VOTE NO** Establishes Ranked Choice Voting. It is being pitched as Open Primaries, but don't buy into that. Several states have tried it and are now trying to remove it. It violates "one person, one vote." Candidates with the most votes can lose. Delays results, complicated, chaotic, expensive.
- **4 VOTE YES** Removes the use of slavery and involuntary servitude as criminal punishments in the state constitution.
- **5 VOTE YES** Provide a sales tax exemption for both child and adult diapers (including disposables).
- **6 VOTE NO** Nevada already permits abortion. The people voted to allow abortion up to 24 weeks. This amendment allows non-doctors to perform abortions through all 9 months. It also allows underage abortions without parental consent or notification. Voting NO on Questions 6 upholds NV Revised Statute (NRS) 442.250.
- **7 VOTE YES** Requires an ID to vote or when voting by paper ballot to verify a voter's identity through the use of the last four digits of driver's license or social security number.
