



Important Chamber Bucks Information

As a Chamber member business, you are able to receive Chamber Bucks in payment for products or services. Below are a few pointers about using and collecting Chamber Bucks.

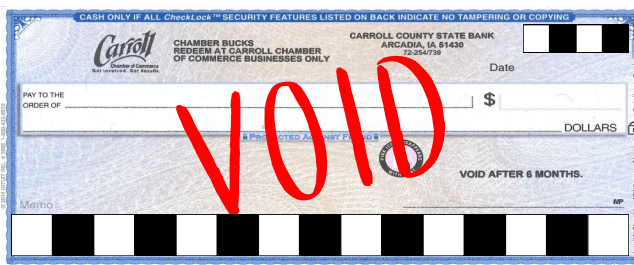


- Customers can use Chamber Bucks just like cash or a check.
- If you run Chamber Bucks through your register to validate them (like you would a check), **DO NOT give them back to the customer.** Put Chamber Bucks in your register with other checks or coupons.
- Chamber Bucks are dated and expire after six months. **DO NOT accept expired Chamber Bucks.** Void date can be found in the memo line.
- If you bank locally (in Carroll), include your Chamber Bucks with your checks deposits.
- If the customers purchase is less than the amount of the Chamber Bucks, you can either give them cash back or store credit. **DO NOT give the customer back the Chamber Bucks.** Put Chamber Bucks in your register with other checks or coupons.



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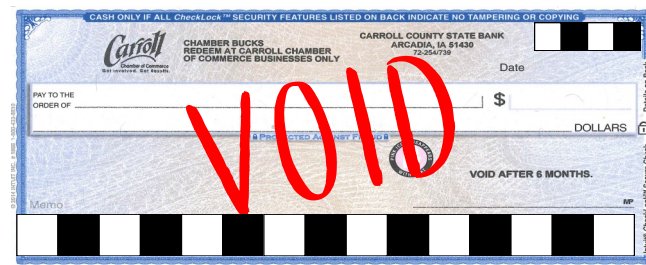


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
