Specifications

Participants are given the opportunity to engage Northwest Ohio's foremost business, education and government policy experts in a dialogue about leadership and their role in creating a thriving economy. The curriculum is designed to incorporate the participant's voice and to engage their views with specific outcomes emphasizing professional and personal growth with a practical business and community orientation.

Curriculum Outline

The curriculum builds from participants' experiences, emphasizing personal and professional development with a practical orientation.

The Hispanic Leadership Institute is a 7-week Program of weekly classes conducted one evening a week. HLI offers participants the opportunity to engage Northwest Ohio's foremost business and policy authorities in a continuing dialogue about leadership and Latino issues. The Hispanic Leadership Institute enhances participant's understanding of the role culture plays in a variety of circumstances, with specific attention to the enduring influence of Latinos in Northwest Ohio.

Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in the Hispanic Leadership Institute all applicants must:

High School Eligibility:

- > Be currently enrolled in grades 11th or 12th
- > Show a strong interest in further developing their leadership skills
- > Be able to commit to the full 7-week experience
- > Obtain a letter of recommendation from the guidance counselor
- > Register at NOHCC.com when registration is open

College Student Eligibility:

- > Be currently enrolled in a college or university
- > Show strong interest in further developing leadership skills
- > Be able to commit to the full 7-week experience
- > Engage in 20 minute interview
- > Register at NOHCC.com when registration is open

Scholarship Available

Registration will be open 8 weeks prior to the start of the next session.

Fall session will begin October 2021 and run for 7 weeks.

Spring session will begin April 2022 and run for 7 weeks.
